

For Interide, It's 'Ready, Set, Grow

Interide Logistics LC is set for explosive growth.

The third-party logistics (3PL) company, an XPO acquisition, serves close to 900 customers in Salt Lake City, Utah; Minneapolis-St. Paul, Minn.; and Louisville, Ky. There are big plans in the works to turn its Salt Lake City headquarters into a “mega-branch” – an office that will potentially add hundreds of employees with target annual revenues of \$300-\$500m over a period of five years.

“We will be going from 11 to 46 employees by the end of the year,” said branch president Sean H. Snow. In 2014, Interide will move out of a temporary facility and into a new permanent space, taking the company from 6,000 sq. ft. to a cushy 15,000. The space will include training facilities and host 150

employees, with an option to add an additional 15,000 sq. ft. The move will bring an abundance of jobs and the establishment of a carrier group. “Our peak goal is 300+ people in the Salt Lake City office,” said Snow.

Industry veteran Snow formed Interide in 2009 with key members of his former executive team, Steven Gadd and Ryan Snow.

The company combines experience and cutting-edge information technology with an asset-based network of equipment options across the nation.
